#### Additional Backup Information:

This action will authorize Austin Public Health to accept and appropriate an additional \$136,125 in grant funds, which represents the difference between the approved appropriation for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 and the grant award of \$2,099,125.

If approved, these funds will help income eligible people living with HIV in the Austin-Round Rock Eligible Metropolitan Statistical Area (also referred to as EMSA) to obtain stable housing.

The approved Fiscal Year 2021-2022 City of Austin Annual Action Plan includes Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (also referred to as HOPWA) funding for sub-recipients as follows:
