

**ORDINANCE NO. 20210826-052**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 20080821-032 TO GRANT AN ADDITIONAL THREE-YEAR EXTENSION OPTION TO THE LICENSE AGREEMENT GRANTING ZNET TEXAS, LP, USE OF CITY RIGHT OF WAY FOR SUBSURFACE CONDUIT PLACEMENT IN DOWNTOWN AUSTIN.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1. FINDINGS.**

- (1) On May 18, 2000, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2000518-052 granting ZNET of Austin, Inc. a license to install in the City's rights of way conduit infrastructure consisting of ten duct systems paired with manholes to provide conduit space for wire facilities.
- (2) On August 21, 2008, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 20080821-032 granting ZNET, Texas, LP, successor to ZNET of Austin, Inc., a revised license to maintain its remaining four duct systems in the City right of way, for a ten-year term with one three-year extension option, the terms of which expire on September 1, 2021

**PART 2.** Section 12(B) of Part 1 of Ordinance No. 20080821-032 is amended to read as follows:

(B) Grantee has an option to renew this license for two additional three-year terms [~~one additional three-year term~~] under the same terms and conditions, provided Grantee has fully complied with all terms and conditions of this license. If Grantee elects to exercise a [the] renewal, it must file a written notice with the City no fewer than six months prior to expiration of the then-current [~~original ten-year~~] license term.

**PART 3.** This ordinance takes effect on September 6, 2021.


