Approve a resolution authorizing the submission of an application for, and acceptance of grant funding in the amount of \$446,540 from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division to implement the Austin Police Department Rifle-Resistant Body Armor Project.

Fiscal Note

Funding is available from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, BG-Rifle-Resistant Body Armor Grant Program (BAGP) for the project period of September 1, 2021 - August 31, 2022. A City funding match is not required.

Prior Council Action:

September 3, 2020 - Council approved resolution No.20200903-008, which approved acceptance of grant funds for this project on a 9-0 vote.

Additional Backup Information:

The City Manager's Office reviewed this grant for alignment as directed by Resolution 20200611-096 and recommends approval.

This action will provide the required resolution needed by the Criminal Justice Division to complete the award process related to \$446,540 in grant funding. The project period is September 1, 2021 - August 31, 2022. A match is not required. Funding will allow the City to outfit an estimated 332 officers with NIJ-rated rifle resistant body armor (replacement equipment).

The grantor requires a resolution approved by council that includes items one through four below.

- 1. Authorization by your governing body for the submission of the application to the Public Safety Office (PSO) that clearly identifies the name of the project for which funding is requested;
- 2. A commitment to provide all applicable matching funds:
- 3. A designation of the name and/or title of an authorized official who is given the authority to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant (Note: If a name is provided, you must update the PSO should the official change during the grant period.); and

A written assurance that, in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the governing body will return all funds to PSO.
