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### **Posting Language**

Authorize negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 7 to an agreement with Austin Independent School District for the provision of tutoring services to youth, to increase funding in an amount not to exceed \$171,059 for a term beginning October 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$1,523,398.

### **Lead Department**

### **Fiscal Note**

Funding in the amount of \$171,059 is available in the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Austin Public Health Department Operating Budget.

### **Prior Council Action:**

March 31, 2016 - Council authorized adding a 6% annual cost of living increase to the 37-month base agreement and each of the three extension options, on an 8-2 vote with Council Members Troxclair and Zimmerman voting no, Mayor Adler absent, and Mayor Pro Tem Tovo recusing herself from contracts associated with Creative Action.

November 20, 2014 - Council authorized execution of a 37-month agreement with 33 social service agencies, or other qualified offerors responding to Request For Proposal No. EAD0116, for self-sufficiency social services for the Austin/Travis County Health and Human Services Department, including Austin Independent School District, with three 12-month extension options for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$1,231,200 on a 6-0 vote with Council Member Tovo recusing herself from contracts associated with Theater Action Project/Creative Action.

### **Additional Backup Information:**

This action will authorize the negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 7 to an agreement with Austin Independent School District to provide academic tutoring to youth. Since Youth Issue Area funding will be competed in Fiscal Year 2021-2022, the extension option will be one nine-month term, beginning October 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$171,059, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$1,523,398.

Amendment No. 6 exercised the third extension option in the amount of \$228,078 for the period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021.

Amendment No. 5 exercised the second extension option in the amount of \$228,078 for the period of October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020.

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Amendment No. 4 exercised the first extension option in the amount of \$228,078 for the period of October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019.

Amendment No. 3 added \$5,563 to the 37-month base agreement due to a 2.5% annual cost of living increase for social services agreements approved by Council during the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Budget adoption process.

Amendment No. 2 added \$10,006 to the to the 37-month base agreement due to a 2.3% annual cost of living increase for social services agreements approved by Council during the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Budget adoption process.

Amendment No. 1 added \$36,936, to the 37-month base agreement due to a 6% annual cost of living increase for social services agreements approved by Council during the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget adoption process.

The current social services agreement with Austin Independent School District was awarded as a result of Austin Public Health Department's Self-Sufficiency Request for Applications in Fiscal Year 2013-2014.

Services began on September 1, 2015 for an initial 37-month term ending on September 30, 2018 in the amount of \$615,600, with three 12-month extension options in the amount of \$205,200 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,231,200.
