Additional Backup Information:

The contract is for planning and design services for the development of a Heritage Tourism comprehensive

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multimodal district wayfinding signage program. The program provides a diverse array of signage types that allow for unique district and site branding within consistent designs. This will promote tourism and the convention and hotel industry and raise the market potential for arts, entertainment, and heritage tourism.

As geographically defined destinations emerge around the city, the City seeks to develop a comprehensive wayfinding system that allows for modifications and expansion as these areas seek to provide a unique and pleasant experience for its visitors and convention delegates. The program will include a variety of sign families including, but not limited to the following: gateway, directional, interpretive, street, district, and temporary signage, in addition to, signage for heritage, cultural, entertainment and historic sites and districts, informational bulletin boards and kiosks, and commercial signage compatible with historic buildings and districts.

This is a new contract to create an appendix to the current City of Austin Master Wayfinding Plan that is specific to historic and heritage district tourism. The contractor will be responsible for understanding and complimenting the existing conditions of wayfinding projects and processes in the City, including the Downtown Wayfinding Master Plan.

An evaluation team with expertise in this area evaluated the offers and scored Found Design LLC d/b/a Merje as the best to provide these services based on contractor experience, personnel qualifications, management structure, project work plan, price, local preference, and service-disabled veteran business enterprise.
