Authorize an amendment to a contract with Solix, Inc. for automatic enrollment administrator services, to increase the amount by \$7,250,000 and to extend the term by five years, for a revised total contract amount not to exceed \$12,424,700.

Additional Backup Information:

The proposed amendment will increase the authorization and provide continued and enhanced support for the automatic enrollment process for Austin Energy (AE) customers eligible to participate in the City of Austin's Utility Bill Discount Program. The automatic enrollment process combines eligibility lists received from AE and local entitlement program offices such as Medicaid, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, Children's Health Insurance Partnership, the Telephone Lifeline Program, Supplemental Security Income benefits, Travis County Medical Assistance Program, Comprehensive Energy Assistance Program, Veterans Affairs

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Supportive Housing Program, and any other entitlement programs that may be approved by the City. The contractor cross references lists of individuals who receive these benefits with lists of City utility services customers in order to determine eligibility for discounted utility service.

The contractor has extensive knowledge of eligibility-based public benefit programs as well as the Customer Assistance Program. Their expertise is unparalleled in the industry.
