Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of an agreement with Belmont Icehouse to enhance awareness of HIV-related treatment and support services, in an amount not to exceed \$274,000 for an initial five-month term and \$150,000 for each of the three 12-month extension options for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$724,000.

Funding in the amount of \$274,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Austin Public Health Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund. Funding for the remaining terms is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

The funding for this contract is provided by the Health Resources and Services Administration for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 beginning March 1, 2021 through February 28, 2022, to support the development and implementation of programs tailored to ending the HIV epidemic in Austin/Travis County. These services will be provided through a subrecipient agreement with a nationally recognized advertising agency.

Recent scientific advances in HIV treatment have made ending the HIV epidemic in America a realistic possibility. The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services set an ambitious goal of reducing all new HIV infections by 75% in five years and 90% by 2030. The contract funding for the "Ending the HIV Epidemic" initiative will enhance awareness of HIV-related treatment and support services available in Austin/Travis County.
