The contract will provide consulting services for childcare center design, financial models, and childcare operator selection for the Dove Springs Public Health Facility scheduled to open in 2023.

Ginsberg Kershner Associates (GKA) has previous experience providing childcare consulting services to the City for the Bergstrom Tech Center childcare facility. GKA has developed childcare financial models including feasibility and analysis, childcare operator request for proposal and proposal analysis, program start up design and implementation, and return on investment development. GKA's work includes assessing potential sites for on-site or near-site centers, center design development, evaluating operational trade-offs, and ensuring regulatory compliance with local, state, and national agencies.

This is a new contract and estimates were based upon GKA's previous Bergstrom Tech Center contract with the City that included similar consulting services. Rates are similar to those for comparable City contracts and are consistent with the standard for this industry. If the City is not able to secure a contract, there will be significant delays for opening the Dove Springs Public Health Facility and further delays to families accessing high quality childcare in the Dove Springs community.
