#### Additional Backup Information:

The requested action is for Council to ratify the contract with Technical Structural Repair Group, LLC which has been procured under authority of Section 252.022(a)(2) of the Texas Local Government Code as a procurement necessary to protect or preserve the public health and safety of the citizens of the municipality, and in this case, citizens of Austin and users of the Austin City Hall garage. Thus, the contract is exempt from statutory competitive bidding requirements.

In October 2020 Building Services reached out to the Public Works Department (PWD) to assess several cracks in the support columns of the Austin City Hall parking garage. After an initial assessment by PWD staff, a forensic engineering consultant conducted a complete structural assessment of the Austin City Hall parking garage. The findings of the structural assessment confirmed the structural integrity of the parking garage columns had been compromised. Five existing columns along both main ramps, 10 columns in total, have experienced different levels of structural damage at multiple levels. The extent of the damage extends into the ramp slab at several locations along the ramps.

Technical Structural Repair Group, LLC specializes in complex structural concrete repairs. The repair design requires specialized concrete demolition, reinforcement installation and carbon-fiber-reinforced polymer which is a specific repair material that is placed in multiple layers using polymer resin between each layer. This specific process must be done to avoid affecting the stability and structural capacity of the columns.

Work commenced in November of 2021 and is expected to be completed by March 2021.
