



Case rate per 100,000 in 7 days / Percent Positivity per CDC

Use the highest one to determine how cases are spreading in the community.

Determining Transmission Risk

If the two indicators suggest different transmission levels, the higher level is selected

Self Testing



Consider Self Testing

- . If you have symptoms
- . After exposure or potential exposure to Covid-19
- Before gathering with others, especially
 - unvaccinated children
 - older adults
 - immunocompromised
 - people at risk for severe disease

Self-tests can also be used as one of many risk-reduction measures, along with vaccination, masking, and physical distancing, that <u>protect you and others</u> by reducing the chance of viral transmission. You can self-test, even if you don't have symptoms or are fully vaccinated, in order to make decisions that will help prevent spreading COVID-19 to others.

- . Masking for everyone in Indoor Public spaces






Patient Vaccination Status







Austin MSA COVID-19 Patients Under 18 Years of Age







Percentage of Austin MSA COVID-19 Patients by Age Group













Vaccinations by Week in Travis County







Pediatric Doses Administered by APH by Race/Ethnicity




Race and Ethnicity of Travis County Residents Ages 5-11







Travis County Residents Who Have Not Received Second Dose






TXDSHS Vaccine Data for Travis County by Race and Ethnicity








First Dose Vaccinated Population
