

**RESOLUTION NO. 20211209-043**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to support the University of Texas in its efforts to establish appropriate uses for potential future development of its properties through the establishment of appropriate zoning; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved Resolution No. 20201203-016, which initiated zoning and rezoning on several properties owned by the University of Texas System; and

**WHEREAS**, the University of Texas System and the City of Austin now plan to include the Pickle Research Campus East Campus property to the tracts being rezoned;

**NOW, THEREFORE,**


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

The City Council initiates the zoning and rezoning, and where appropriate neighborhood plan amendments of the Pickle Research East Campus, generally located east of the Union Pacific Railroad tracks, south of Braker Lane, west of Burnet Road and north of Innovation Drive;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

The City Manager is directed to process the applications and work in collaboration with the University of Texas and stakeholders to recommend

appropriate zoning, rezoning, and neighborhood plan amendments, and take necessary steps to ensure an efficient rezoning process to avoid unnecessary delay.
