





Figure 4. TxS2 ILI Percentage Syndromic Surveillance Data, Travis County: 2018-2022








Percentage of Austin MSA COVID-19 Patients by Age Group










Distinct Cases and Cumulative Cases by Onset Date and Role







Pediatric Doses Administered by APH by Race/Ethnicity


Race and Ethnicity of Travis County Residents Ages 5-11








Travis County Residents Who Have Not Received Second Dose




TXDSHS Vaccine Data for Travis County by Race and Ethnicity








First Dose Vaccinated Population


- 1) Mask up! Stage 4 means everyone should wear masks, regardless of vaccination status when gathering with people outside their household, traveling, dining, and shopping.
