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Due to unforeseen rental demands from Winter Storm Uri and other infrastructure upgrade projects, there is insufficient spending authority to maintain the contract through its term. The contract, based on the U.S. Communities Government Purchasing Alliance cooperative contract is scheduled to expire on October 31, 2023.

The contract is necessary to provide City departments with a reliable and continuous source for renting heavyduty equipment and vehicles for daily use, high demand situations, and special projects.
