# Additional Backup Information:

The contract will support the pilot of the City's guaranteed income program ("Program"). The goal of the Program is to develop a repeatable program design to integrate guaranteed income with other public support services. As a result of this Program, the contractor will provide 85 families and individuals monthly payments of \$1,000.

The contractor will also conduct an evaluation of the program. The evaluation will include analysis of survey and interview data, as well as additional case studies with participants seeking to make recommendations and measure impact in key areas such as economic mobility, social capital, and housing stability. This analysis will be done through a partnership between the contractor, UpTogether, and Urban Institute researchers.
