7	absence at full pay for police officers who suffer illness or injury related to the
8	officer's line of duty; and
9	WHEREAS, Officer Neely began a leave of absence, at full pay, on
10	February 11, 2021; and
11	WHEREAS, Officer Neely's leave of absence expired on or about February
12	11, 2022; and
13	WHEREAS, Officer Neely is currently undergoing treatment for his illness
14	and intends to return to work when medically cleared; and
15	WHEREAS, the Civil Service Act authorizes a municipality's governing
15 16	WHEREAS, the Civil Service Act authorizes a municipality's governing body to extend a police officer's leave of absence for a line of duty illness; NOW,

19 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

20	The leave of absence for Officer Elijah Neely's February 11, 2021, line of
21	duty related illness, authorized by section 143.073 of the Texas Local Government
22	Code, is hereby extended, at full pay, until August 15, 2022. This extension shall
23	cover additional periods of leave necessitated by Office Neely's illness, up to a
24	maximum of six months of additional leave.
