



- Project-based rental assistance
- Awarded by HACA
- Operating subsidy
- Environmental Review
- Subsidy Layering Review





Rehabilitation

- Conversion from Hotel to Residences
- Add Kitchenettes
- Scope of Work provided by operator
- American Rescue Plan funds





<u>Ownership</u>

- Transfer ownership to AHFC
- Added to Residential Asset portfolio
- Property Tax Abatement
- Asset Management and Portfolio Management

- Property Maintenance
- Day-to-day management
- Capital Reserves
- Monitored by AHFC

- Wraparound Services
- Available and accessible to all residents
- Set up for success

- Transfer to AHFC Expected in May

- Environmental Review Approval Expected 5/12/22
- Subsidy Layering Review to HUD After 5/12/22
- HUD Approval Expected in June

- Subsidy Layering Review with HUD
- Applied for MFDL for Rehab
- Transfer to AHFC Expected in May
