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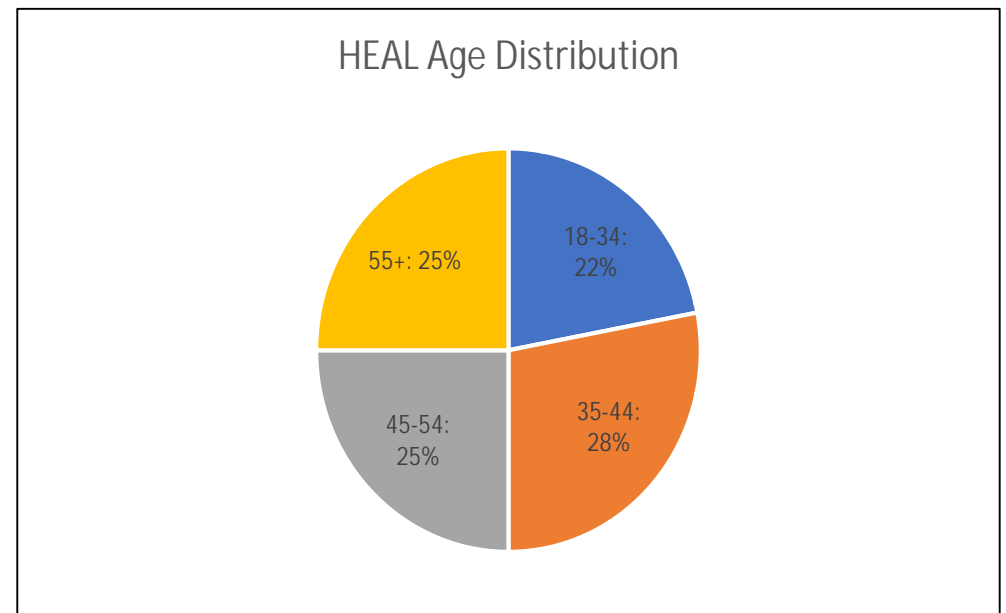
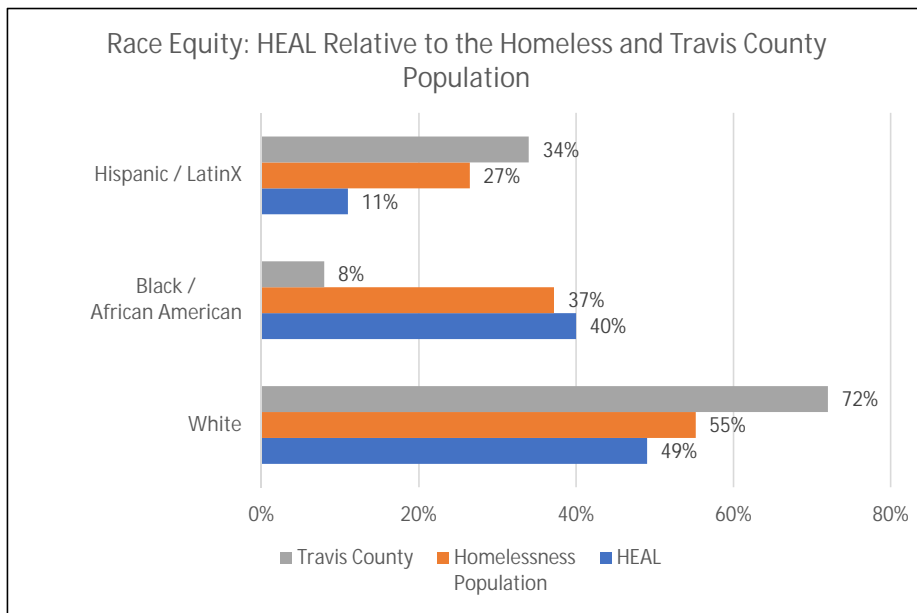
Progress since February Briefing

- Two New Encampments Resolved
 - West Bouldin Creek
 - St. Johns Neighborhood Park
- Shelter & Permanent Housing Placements
 - + 65 unsheltered individuals relocated to bridge shelter
 - + 26 individuals placed into permanent Housing
- Program Staffing
 - Program Supervisor for Northbridge Shelter hired 4/11
 - Program Manager I posted (Encampment Management)

HEAL Initiative: Individuals Served

- Fiscal Year 2022 Goal: 200
- Actual through 3/31/22: 99 (On Target)
- Inception to date: 247

Bridge Shelter Operations

Shelter Acceptance Rate:	90%
Bridge Shelter Census:	111

Progress toward Permanent Housing:

Completed Coordinated Assessment:	90%
Enrolled in Permanent Housing Program:	65%

Permanent Housing Efforts

Rapid Rehousing:

- Family Eldercare & Integral Care
- 58 Rehoused to date (23% rate)
- 70 Additional Enrolled in RRH (Seeking Housing)

APH Housing Stability Solicitation

- \$38M for RRH via ARPA
- At least \$6M HEAL-related RRH
- July target contract execution
