Additional Backup Information:

This action will provide funding for a two-year pilot project, which will place a dedicated Community School Coordinator (Coordinator) in four targeted communities (North Central, North East, Central East, and Dove Springs). The Coordinators will link community partners, local campuses, parents, and grassroots organizations to an existing network of Family Resource Centers to increase access to resources, as well as to provide regular opportunities for parents and community members to work together to plan campus and community improvements, particularly those related to increasing community resiliency.
