



26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

27 Pursuant to Section 11.3(c) of Texas' Qualified Allocation Plan and Section  
28 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code, the City Council expressly  
29 acknowledges and confirms that the City has more than twice the state average of  
30 units per capita supported by Housing Tax Credits or Private Activity Bonds.

31 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

32 Pursuant to Section 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' Qualified Allocation Plan, the  
33 City Council acknowledges that the proposed Development is located in a census  
34 tract that has more than 20% Housing Tax Credit Units per total households.

35 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

36 Pursuant to Section 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code and  
37 Sections 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' Qualified Allocation Plan, the City Council  
38 supports the proposed Development; approves the construction of the  
39 Development; authorizes an allocation of Housing Tax Credits for the  
40 Development; and affirms that the Development is consistent with the City's  
41 obligation to affirmatively further fair housing.

42 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

43 The City Council authorizes, empowers, and directs Myrna Rios, City Clerk,  
44 to certify this resolution to the TDHCA.
