Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of an interlocal agreement with Austin Independent School District (AISD) for the City's use of AISD's facilities and related services so City can provide public health services to Austin/Travis County residents, for a 19-month term beginning January 11, 2021 with four 12-month renewal options, each in an amount not to exceed \$500,000.

Funding in the amount of \$500,000 is available from the U.S. Department of Treasury, American Rescue Plan Act. Funding for the remaining terms is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Approval of the negotiation and execution of an interlocal agreement with the Austin Independent School District (AISD) will ensure the City's continued provision of public health services in the form of medical countermeasures to the Austin/Travis County community, including COVID-19 services, which consist of vaccine administration, testing, and other related services. The Austin Public Health Department (APH) is seeking to execute this interlocal agreement with AISD to provide reimbursement to AISD for the City's past and future use of several AISD-facilities.

Before, during, and after APH-events, AISD has provided and will continue to provide temporary spaces and related services that include security, custodial, janitorial, trash removal, and cleaning, as well as water, sanitary sewer, and electric utilities.
