WHEREAS, the City is eligible for \$11,441,252 in American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds administered by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through its Home Investment Partnership Program (HOME) for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 (the "HOME-ARP Grant"); and

WHEREAS, an allocation plan for the HOME-ARP Grant (HOME-ARP Allocation Plan) describing a spending plan and the process City staff went through to gather feedback from the community will be included as an amendment to the City's Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(1), (2), and (3):

- 1. identified in its Fiscal Years 2019-2024 Consolidated Plan, adopted on June 6, 2019, areas of the municipality in which predominantly lowand moderate-income persons reside, or that are blighted or slum areas; and
- 2. established in its Fiscal Years 2019-2024 Consolidated Plan, adopted on June 6, 2019, community development program areas in which community development activities, building rehabilitation, or the acquisition of privately owned buildings or land are proposed; and
- 3. adopted a Citizen Participation Plan (CCP) under which residents may publicly comment on proposed community development programs (Resolution No. 960328-31, as amended by Resolution Nos. 000113-29, 040129-8, 20111215-089, and 20200521-014) and the American Rescue Plan Act homelessness spending framework (Resolution No. 20210610-077); and

 WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the City Council conducted a public hearing on June 9, 2022, to obtain public comment on the proposed HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Community Development Commission conducted a public hearing on May 10, 2022, to obtain public comment on the proposed HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City made the proposed HOME-ARP Allocation Plan available for public comment from May 3, 2022 to June 10, 2022; **NOW**, **THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council approves the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan (attached to this resolution and identified as **Exhibit A**).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit, attest, execute, and deliver the necessary grant applications, certifications, and other related documents including, but not limited to, applications, a final statement of community development objectives, projected use of funds, and any required certifications, and to negotiate, as necessary, with HUD for the HOME-ARP Grant.
