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- 21 3. the City Council has held a hearing at which public comment could be
22 made on the proposed Development as required by Subsection (b); and
23 4. after due consideration of the information provided by the Applicant and
24 public comment, the City Council does not object to the Applicant's
25 proposed application to the TDHCA.

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

27 Pursuant to Section 11.3(c) of Texas' Qualified Allocation Plan and Section
28 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code, the City Council expressly
29 acknowledges and confirms that the City has more than twice the state average of
30 units per capita supported by housing tax credits or private activity bonds.

31 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

32 Pursuant to Section 11.3 of Texas' Qualified Allocation Plan, the City
33 Council acknowledges that the proposed Development is located one linear mile or
34 less from a development that serves the same type of household as the
35 Development and has received an allocation of housing tax credits (or private
36 activity bonds) within the three-year period preceding the date the Certificate of
37 Reservation is issued.

38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

39 Pursuant to Section 2306.6703(a)(4) of the Texas Government Code and
40 Sections 11.3 and 11.4 of Texas' Qualified Allocation Plan, the City Council

41 supports the proposed Development, approves the construction of the
42 Development, and authorizes an allocation of housing tax credits for the
43 Development.

44 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

45 The City Council authorizes, empowers, and directs Myrna Rios, City Clerk,
46 to certify this resolution to the TDHCA.
