Posting Language

Authorize award of a contract with Rush Truck Centers of Texas LP d/b/a Rush Truck Center San Antonio or Rush Truck Center Austin to provide steering, suspension, and alignment repair services with associated parts, for a term of five years in an amount not to exceed \$390,000.

Additional Backup Information:

The contract will provide steering, suspension, and alignment repair services with associated parts for the City's fleet of medium and heavy-duty vehicles and equipment. These services will supplement the repairs performed by the Fleet Mobility Services technicians.

This contract will replace a contract which expires September 9, 2022. The requested authorization amount for this contract was determined using departmental estimates, historical spend, and anticipated price increases

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over the term of the contract. The recommended contractor is the current provider for these services.

If the City is unable to secure a contract, departments will not have a reliable and continuous source for steering, suspension, and alignment services. In addition, the City will be forced to procure these services on an as needed basis, which may result in higher prices and operational costs.
