Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 3 to an agreement with Foundation Communities to improve and expand access to physical health, mental health, and dental care services, to add two 12-month extension options each in an amount not to exceed \$125,000, for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$625,000.

Fiscal Note

Funding in the amount of \$125,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Austin Public Health Department Operating Budget. Funding for the remaining terms is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Prior Council Action:

August 8, 2019 - City Council authorized award, negotiation, and execution of a 13-month agreement with Foundation Communities in an amount not to exceed \$125,000, with two 12-month extension options each in an amount not to exceed \$125,000, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$375,000, on an 11-0 vote.

Additional Backup Information:

Approval of Amendment No. 3 will continue funding for Foundation Communities to provide basic needs healthcare services, improving and expanding access to physical health care, mental health care, and dental care services.

Amendment No. 2 exercised the second extension option in the amount of \$125,000 for the period of October 1, 2021, to September 30, 2022.

Amendment No. 1 exercised the first extension option in the amount of \$125,000 for the period of October 1, 2020, to September 30, 2021.

The current social services agreement with Foundation Communities was awarded through a 2019 Request for Applications for the provision of improved and expanded access to physical health care, mental health care, and dental care services, with services beginning on September 1, 2019 for an initial 13-month period in the amount of \$125,000 per extension option, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$375,000.
