22           **WHEREAS**, most Downtown City-owned garages have excess parking that  
23 they can make available to individuals for an hourly or block-period rate; and

24           **WHEREAS**, parking fees in City-owned garages get applied toward the  
25 costs of operating that facility and, when relevant, toward debt payments; and

26           **WHEREAS**, the City has not done cost of service studies to update the  
27 pricing in its parking garages, and while assets such as the Seaholm Garage tend to  
28 charge higher rates indistinguishable from other garages in the area, the City Hall  
29 and Convention Center garages have instituted rates that may not return the cost to  
30 provide the service; and

31           **WHEREAS**, City Council raised parking garage rates at the City Hall  
32 garage to better reflect its costs of maintaining and operating the parking garage  
33 and the building; and

34           **WHEREAS**, the Convention Center Garages, located near the Red Line  
35 train station and bus routes 1, 3, 6, 7, 10, 17, and 803 attract many visitors to the  
36 Downtown and Rainey Street area, especially during evening hours; and

37           **WHEREAS**, the Convention Center has the following rates approved by  
38 Council as part of the fees and fines to be set or charged by the City for Fiscal Year  
39 2022-2023:

0 – 30 minutes	Grace Period
30 minutes – 1 hour	\$10.00
1 hour – 2 hours	\$20.00
2 hours – 3 hours	\$30.00
3 hours – 4 hours	\$40.00
4 hours – 24 hours	\$48.00

41           **WHEREAS**, the Convention Center can and does validate parking tickets  
42 for free or discounted rates for conventions and events taking place; and

43           **WHEREAS**, parking fee revenue is used to pay off debt related to the  
44 Convention Center; and

45           **WHEREAS**, the City of Austin has a responsibility to manage and operate  
46 its building and facilities in a fiscally responsible manner; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

47 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

48           The City Council establishes the following revised fees for the Convention  
49 Center parking garage for the Fiscal Year 2023:

50           First 30 minutes: free (no change)

51           \$10/hour

52           Maximum charge: \$48

53 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

54           The Convention Center shall participate in the City of Austin's Affordable  
55 Parking Program.

56 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

57           The City Manager is directed to produce quarterly reports showing the  
58 impact of the increased hourly rates and to bring forward action to Council to  
59 change those fees, if appropriate. The City Manager shall also include in these  
60 reports information detailing the number and total value of validated parking  
61 tickets and contracts.

62 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

63 The City Manager shall present information to City Council prior to or  
64 during Fiscal Year 2024 budget deliberations about parking rates and revenues at  
65 the Austin Convention Center and other City-owned garages.
