

RESOLUTION NO.

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3 **WHEREAS**, on October 18, 2007, the Council passed Ordinance No.
4 20071018-008 electing to participate in the Texas Enterprise Zone Program and
5 make local incentives and economic development tools available to qualifying
6 enterprise projects; and,

7 **WHEREAS**, Council expanded this list of local incentives and economic
8 development tools in City Ordinance Nos. 20101104-046 and 20191114-068; and,

9 **WHEREAS**, the Governor’s Office of Economic Development and Tourism
10 through the Economic Development Bank will consider the project proposed by
11 Flextronics America LLC (“Flextronics”) as an Enterprise Project pursuant to a
12 nomination and an application made by the City; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the City desires to create the proper economic and social
14 environment to induce the investment of private resources in productive business
15 enterprises located in the City and to provide employment to residents of enterprise
16 zones, veterans and other economically disadvantaged individuals; and

17 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Chapter 2303, Subchapter F of the Texas
18 Enterprise Zone Act, Texas Government Code ("Act"), Flextronics has applied to
19 the City for designation as an enterprise project; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the City finds that Flextronics meets the criteria for
21 designation as an Enterprise Project as required by the Act based on the following
22 grounds:

- 23 a) Flextronics is a “qualified business” under the Act because it will be
24 engaged in the active conduct of a trade or business at a qualified
25 business site within the City’s jurisdiction located outside of an

26 enterprise zone and at least thirty-five percent (35%) of the business'
27 new permanent jobs will be residents of an enterprise zone,
28 economically disadvantaged individuals or veterans; and

29 b) There has been and will continue to be a high level of cooperation
30 between public, private, and neighborhood entities within the area;
31 and

32 c) The designation of Flextronics as an enterprise project will contribute
33 significantly to the achievement of the plans of the City for
34 development and revitalization of the area; and

35 **WHEREAS**, the City finds that Flextronics meets the criteria for
36 local incentives and economic development tools adopted by the City and
37 nominates Flextronics for Enterprise Project status on the grounds that this
38 Enterprise Project will be located at the qualified business site and will create a
39 higher level of employment, economic activity, and stability in the area; and

40 **WHEREAS**, the City finds that it is in the best interest of the City to
41 nominate Flextronics as an Enterprise Project pursuant to the Act; **NOW,**
42 **THEREFORE,**

43 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

44 The City nominates Flextronics America LLC as an Enterprise Project
45 pursuant to Chapter 2303 of the Texas Government Code.

46 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

47 That the findings of the City and its actions approving this Resolution taken
48 at the Council meeting are hereby approved and adopted.

49 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

50 That Flextronics America LLC is a “qualified business” as defined in
51 Section 2303.402 of the Act and meets the criteria for designation as an Enterprise
52 Project, as set forth in Chapter 2303, Subchapter F of the Act.

53 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

54 The local incentives offered to Flextronics America LLC are the same as
55 those provided in Ordinance Nos. 20071018-008, 20101104-046, and 20191114-
56 068.

57 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

58 The Enterprise Project shall take effect on the date of designation of the
59 Enterprise Project by the Governor’s Office of Economic Development and
60 Tourism and terminate five years from the date of designation.

61 This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
