

RESOLUTION NO. 20220901-134

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2022, City Council approved Resolution No. 20220728-069 finding the use of the Competitive Sealed Proposal (the “CSP”) method of contracting, as authorized by Subchapter D, Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code, was the project delivery method that provides the best value to the City related to the development of park improvements for the Rainey Street Trailhead project (the “Project”) and authorizing negotiation and execution of a Parkland Improvement and Maintenance Agreement with the Trail Foundation for a total contract amount not to exceed \$778,865.00; and

WHEREAS, the CSP method allows evaluation of not just price but a contractor's successful experience in coordinating, phasing, performing, and completing construction activities for public facilities, as well as the opportunity to compare contractors’ experience completing like projects on time and within budget of all proposals received, to determine the best value to the City; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that assigning a lower weighted value to price in the selection criteria related to the Project is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Resolution No. 20220728-069 is amended by adding a determination that assigning a lower weighted value to price in the selection criteria related to the Project is in the public interest and assigning a price weighted value of 36.9 percent of the total weighted value of all selection criteria related to the development of the Project.

Except as amended by this Resolution, Resolution No. 20220728-069 remains in full force and effect.
