## ORDINANCE NO. 680812-B

AN ORDINANCE ORDERING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF AUSTIN ON OCTOBER 19, 1968 SO THAT THE VOTERS OF THE CITY MAY APPROVE OR REJECT A PROPOSED FAIR HOUSING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN ENACTING PROVISIONS INCIDENT AND RELATING TO THE PURPOSES OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a referendum petition for the submission of Ordinance No. 680517-A to the voters was filed on May 24, 1968, and certified by the City Clerk on June 20, 1968 as having been signed by at least 10% of the qualified voters of the City; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the City Charter the City Council has now duly reconsidered the referred Ordinance and has repealed the same; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to have the benefit of the expressed judgment of the voters with respect to a new and revised Fair Housing Ordinance which has been recommended to the City Council by the Human Relations Commission and many other citizens after numerous additional public hearings thereon, and to pledge to the voters that their City Council will abide by the decision of the voters with respect to the enactment, or not, of such new and revised Fair Housing Ordinance; Now, Therefore,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

SECTION 1. That a special municipal election is hereby ordered and directed to be held at the various polling places in the City of Austin, Texas, as hereinafter designated, on the third Saturday in October, being the 19th day of October, 1968 from the hours of 7:00 o'clock A.M. to 7:00 o'clock P.M. at which election there shall be submitted to the qualified voters of said City for their approval or rejection at the polls, a proposed Fair Housing Ordinance of the City of Austin, being Ordinance No. 680812-A.

SECTION 2. That said election shall be held under the provisions of and in accordance with the provisions of the Charter and ordinances of the City of Austin and the Laws of the State of Texas, so far as may be applicable.

SECTION 3. That the ballots for said election shall be prepared in sufficient number and in conformity with the Texas Election Code, and that printed on such ballots shall appear substantially the following:
