ORDINANCE NO. 95- 1019-G

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 950911-B, THE 1995-96 CAPITAL BUDGET, BY ACCEPTING AN INTERMODAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION EFFICIENCY ACT (ISTEA) GRANT OF \$542,244.80 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; APPROPRIATING \$542,244.80 IN GRANT FUNDS TO THE SPECIAL REVENUE FUND OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PLAZA SALTILLO IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTIONS 2-2-3, 2-2-5 AND 2-2-7 OF THE AUSTIN CITY CODE OF 1992, AS AMENDED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. That Ordinance No. 950911-B, the 1995-96 Capital Budget, be and the same is hereby amended by accepting an Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) grant of \$542,244.80 from the Texas Department of Transportation; appropriating \$542,244.80 in grant funds to the Special Revenue Fund of the Department of Public Works and Transportation for the Plaza Saltillo Improvement Project.

PART 2. That the requirements imposed by Sections 2-2-3, 2-2-5 and 2-2-7 of the Austin City Code of 1992, as amended, regarding the presentation and adoption of ordinances are hereby waived by the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members of the City Council.

PART 3. That the need to accept and appropriate funding for the Plaza Saltillo Improvements Project creates an emergency and an emergency is hereby declared to exist; therefore the City Council hereby declares that the grave public necessity of accepting and appropriating these funds constitutes an unusual and unforeseen condition, which could not, by reasonable diligence, thought, and attention, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Therefore, this ordinance is hereby passed as an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and shall be effective immediately upon its final passage.


