WHEREAS, Central Texas Engineers Week encourages Central Texas school children to pursue technology careers by providing role models from the local engineering community; and

WHEREAS, diverse groups of engineers provide hands on experiments that demonstrate teamwork and logical processes while discussing their jobs and the reasons they chose engineering for students from elementary school to high school; and

WHEREAS, the Central Texas Engineers Week program, which includes four annual community events, reached more than 29,000 students in the past academic year; and

WHEREAS, the organizers for the Central Texas Engineers Week are hosting volunteer mixers to inform prospective participants of 2005 National Engineers Week activities; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council directs the City Manager to encourage engineers working for the City of Austin to participate in Central Texas Engineers Week, which takes place February 20 to 26, 2005, and related events in 2005; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The City Council directs the City Manager to contact Central Texas Engineers Week organizers to coordinate a volunteer mixer for City of Austin employees to take place before February 20, 2005.
