AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING TAXIMETER RATES OF FARE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 991216-31.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The City council adopts the taximeter rates of fare upon the recommendation of the city manager.

PART 2. From February 22, 2005 through midnight on February 19, 2007 the following rates apply:

For the first ¼ mile or fraction	\$2.00
For each additional 1/8 mile or fraction	\$0.25
For each 40 seconds or fraction of waiting time (\$22.50/hour)	\$0.25

From February 20, 2007 through midnight on February 18, 2008, the following rates apply:

For the first ¼ mile or fraction	\$2.00
For each additional 1/8 mile or fraction	\$0.25
For each additional 36 seconds or fraction of waiting time (\$25.00/hour)	\$0.25

From February 19, 2008 through midnight on February 16, 2009, the following rates apply:

For the first 1/8 mile or fraction	\$2.00
For each additional 1/8 mile or fraction	\$0.25
For each additional 36 seconds or fraction of waiting time (\$25.00/hour)	\$0.25

Effective February 17, 2009 the following rates apply:

For the first 1/8 mile or fraction	\$2.00
For each additional 1/8 mile or fraction	\$0.25
For each additional 33.33 seconds or fraction of waiting time (\$27.00/hour)	\$0.25
