## **SMOKING ORDINANCE**

Comparison of proposed ballot measure ordinance with existing ordinance

- In general, the proposed ordinance provides fewer exceptions and eliminates the current permitting process.
  - I. Exceptions eliminated

Provisions for smoking permits applicable to bars and restaurants.

Bowling alleys.

Enclosed meeting room for private functions.

II. Change in enforcement provision

Elimination of the requirement of non-smoking live music performances.

Elimination of the three violation provision.

III. Remaining exceptions as proposed in the ballot measure

Residential dwelling unit

Hotel or motel room (25% of rooms)

Retail Tobacco store

Private or semi-private room in nursing home

Outdoor area of a workplace

Bingo facilities

Fraternal Organization

A business premise that was issued a Restricted Permit by the City on or before November 2, 2004. Exemption terminates on September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012.
