The City of Austin Health and Human Services Department was identified by the Health and Services Administration (HRSA) as a recipient of \$491,782 in Federal support for a "Health Care and Other Facilities" construction/renovation project. This funding was provided by the Fiscal Year 2003 Department of Health and Human Services Appropriation Act (Public Law 10807).

The South Austin Neighborhood Center is located at 2508 Durwood Street, adjacent to Gillis Park. The scope of this project is twofold: renovations of selected areas inside the existing Center and exterior structural repairs to the building's retaining wall located adjacent to Bouldin Creek. The interior work will improve service to the Center's clientele by providing additional enclosed office space, ADA improvements to restroom facilities, enlargement of medical records storage area, and dedicated restrooms for staff. Some cosmetic improvements to the existing finishes will also be undertaken. The exterior work will mostly address structural repairs required to the facility's retaining wall, which is being undermined by creek erosion. Improvements and restoration of the creek bank in proximity to the building to stabilize the bank are also included.

The contract allows 180 calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 11 general contractors. Bids were opened on November 10, 2004. Wurzel Builders, Ltd. submitted the lowest of 6 bids received:


