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SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a construction contract with MUNIZ CONCRETE AND CONTRACTING, INC. (MBE-MH 96.71%), Austin, TX, for ADA Sidewalk, Ramp and Bikeway Improvements 2004-2007 Group 1 Re-Bid in an amount not to exceed \$1,622,036 and a \$162,203.60 contingency for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,784,239.60.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$1,784,239.60 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Amended Capital Budget of the Public Works Department.

As part of the City's ongoing effort to comply with the directives of the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the Public Works Department has developed more efficient and cost effective methods for sidewalk and curb ramp construction. The City also recognizes that improved and expanded pedestrian facilities are also a frequently requested infrastructure improvement from the public at large. The projects proposed for construction under this initiative have been previously approved by one of the following methods: Council approval of proposed CMTA ¼ cent projects, Build Greater Austin projects, ADA Task Force projects, Child Safety program sidewalks, 1998 Bond funded Neighborhood sidewalks and Bicycle Plan projects.

The construction method chosen to deliver the initiatives is an Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract. The IDIQ contract documents include engineered details, specifications; project locations currently identified and estimated total quantities of work. As each project location is further defined, a specific "work assignment" is given to the Contractor and they complete the scope of work for the unit prices included in the Contract. This contracting method also allows for the flexibility of adding projects based on priorities designated by Public Works.


The purpose of the Contract is to have a Contractor available to complete bike, pedestrian and accessibility projects on a unit price basis. The City has been divided into three separate areas and is awarding an IDIQ contract to each area. This IDIQ contract is considered Group 1 and includes the area of the City south of Cesar Chavez.

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The contract is for an estimated period of one year and allows for 60 calendar days for completion of each work assignment unless otherwise stipulated in writing. A 10% contingency has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders.

Bid documents were distributed to 5 general contractors. Bids were opened on December 6, 2004. Muniz Concrete and Contracting Inc. submitted the lowest of 4 bids received:

Muniz Concrete and Contracting, Austin, TX \$1,622,036.00

Joe Bland Construction, LP, Austin, TX \$1,685,232.50

MAC Inc., Austin, TX \$1,700,150.00

Dayco Construction Co., Austin, TX \$1,817,924.00

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for 2 areas of subcontracting opportunities: Barricades/signs/traffic handling and fuel supply.

Project specific subgoals stated in the solicitation were 6.34% African American; 19.24% Hispanic; 1.72% Asian American; 0.71% Native American; 6.86% WBE. Total participation estimated on base bid amount of \$1,622,036.00:

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
