The project provides for the construction of a 10-foot wide shared use bicycle and pedestrian trail approximately 3,300 linear feet long. The trail begins at the intersection of Pleasant Valley Road and Oltorf Street, and connects to the existing bicycle path at Burleson Road.

This trail is part of the City's Comprehensive Urban Trail System. The Trail System is estimated to receive more than 500,000 annual visits. The trail system will provide users with a means for traveling to work, schools, restaurants, other businesses, government offices, parks, and special events in the downtown area. The trail will link with the rest of the Urban Trail System, and, by serving as an alternative to the use of single occupancy motor vehicles, will contribute to improving Austin's air quality.

The contract allows 120 calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 6 general contractors. Bids were opened on January 6, 2005. Prism Development, Inc. submitted the lowest of 3 bids received:

Prism Development, Inc., Austin, TX \$425,083.75 Muniz Concrete & Contracting, Inc., Austin, TX \$471,492.00 Mac, Inc., Austin, TX \$473,000.00

The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for 5 areas of subcontracting opportunities: site work, traffic control, handrail, and erosion control.


