<u>SUBJECT</u>: Authorize negotiation and execution of an artwork commission agreement with LaMA VENTURES, Dallas, TX, for a sculpture with functional drinking fountains for Second Street District Streetscape Improvement Project, in an amount not to exceed \$78,000.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Funding for these services is available from the Art in Public Places allocation of \$62,000 from the Second Street District Streetscape Improvement Project ; and \$16,000 from the Ullrich Water Treatment Plant.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This contract with LaMa Ventures represents one of two commission agreements related to the Second Street District Streetscape Improvement Public Art Project.

The Springs Project consists of a series of two sculptural environments to include a water feature (drinking fountain) and, possibly, seating areas along alternating blocks of the north sidewalk on Second Street. The selected artists shall work integrally with the SSD-SIP Design Team on the development of an environmental, sculptural artwork or "zone" planned for the streetscape. The artists for each project will be placed under a design contract to begin collaborating with the project consultants and create design proposals for each intersection. Final designs will be reviewed and approved by the AIPP Panel and the Arts Commission before artists may proceed with the fabrication and installation phases.

SELECTION PROCESS

Texas artists in the AIPP Image Registry and mailing list were notified via postcard and e-mail to submit qualifications by July 31, 2004 (this deadline was extended to August 20, 2004). Artists were also notified of the project through local media and the AIPP web site. The Springs Project was open to artists statewide.

The Selection Panel and Advisors reviewed the qualifications (letters of interest, resumes, images of past work, image lists, references and letters of recommendation) of 12 artists/artist teams. The Selection Panel and Advisors selected 4 finalists for The Springs Project whom they interviewed. The panel unanimously recommended the artist team of Philip Lamb and Susan Magilow for the Springs Project to be located on Block 17.
