The Downtown Development Fund was established in 1999 with a balance of \$600,000 for music venue relocation, only a portion of which has been used for that program. Currently that fund has a balance of \$188,312 which is available for use in the expanded Legendary Music Venue Relocation and Redevelopment Program.

Further, in October 2003 the City received a repayment of principal and interest on the Liberty Lunch loan which was deposited into the General Fund with other one-time monies. The net amount of this repayment is \$509,465 which is also available for use. The remaining \$52,223 needed for the expanded program is available from prior year departmental savings in the General Fund.
