SUBJECT: Approve an ordinance amending Section 12-4-63 of the City Code by adding a 20 miles per hour school zone speed limit to a portion of Rio Grande Street for Pease Elementary School and by amending the school zone on Doris Drive for Burnet Middle School; and amending Section 12-4-42 of the City Code by adding a portion of Cameron Road to the list of streets having a maximum speed limit of 40 miles per hour; and amending Section 12-4-44 of the City Code by adding a portion of Dessau Road to the list of streets having a maximum speed limit of 50 miles per hour.
AMOUNT \& SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of $\$ 10,600$ is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Operating Budget of the Public Works Department.

#### Abstract

The Transportation Division of the Public Works Department has completed an investigation on Rio Grande Street in the vicinity of Pease Elementary School. Traffic volumes, traffic speeds, and pedestrian volumes and patterns were evaluated in order to determine what, if any modifications could be made to improve the safety of the students attending Pease Elementary School. As a result of this investigation, the Transportation Division is recommending the installation of a reduced speed school zone on Rio Grande Street from W. 11 th Street to W. 12 th Street.


Amendment to Code Section 12-4-63 (20 MPH School Zone)
Add: Rio Grande Street from West $11^{\text {th }}$ Street to West $12^{\text {th }}$ Street (Pease Elementary School).

In order to modify or alter the existing prima facie speed limit of a street, the Texas Traffic Laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. The investigation was conducted by the Public Works Department in accordance with the procedures specified in the Texas Procedures for Establishing Speed Zones, 1997. As a result of this investigation, the Transportation Division recommends the following.

Add: Cameron Road from Parmer Lane (FM 734) to 320 feet east of Yager Lane.

Amend Section 12-4-63 of the Austin City Code to correct the description of the reduced speed school zone on Doris Drive for Burnet Junior High School.

The current code section incorrectly describes the speed zone as 300 feet west of Hathaway Drive. The code section should read as follows: 192 feet west of Hathaway Drive to 300 feet east of Hathaway Drive.

Prior to the annexation of this section of Dessau Road, December 31, 2004, Travis County conducted a speed zone investigation. As a result of this investigation, a speed limit of 50 mph was recommended and installed on Dessau Road. The Transportation Division of the Public Works Department recommends adopting the previous speed zone investigation completed by Travis County and adding the following to the City Code Section 12-4-44.

Amendment to Code Section 12-4-44 (50 MPH Speed Limit)
Dessau Road from Parmer Lane (FM 734) to Bradbury Lane.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-4-42 OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD A PORTION OF CAMERON ROAD TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 40 MILES PER; AMENDING SECTION 12-4-44 OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD A PORTION OF DESSAU ROAD TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 50 MILES PER HOUR; AND AMENDING SECTION 12-4-63 OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD PORTIONS OF RIO GRANDE STREET AND DORIS DRIVE TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MILES PER HOUR DURING CERTAIN TIMES.


## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-42 (Maximum Speed Limit of 40 Miles Per Hour) of the City Code is amended to add:

Cameron Road from Parmer Lane (FM 734) to 320 feet east of Yager Lane.
PART 2. Section 12-4-44 (Maximum Speed Limit of 50 Miles Per Hour) of the City Code is amended to read:

Dessau Road from 580 feet north of Brighton Lane to Bradbury Lane [ParmerLane (FM734)].

PART 3. Section 12-4-63 (20 Mile Per Hour School Zones) is amended to add:
Rio Grande Street from West $11^{\text {th }}$ Street to West 12 Street (Pease Elementary School).

PART 4. Section 12-4-63 (20 Mile Per Hour School Zones) is amended to read:
Doris Drive from 192 feet west of Hathaway Drive to 300 feet east [west] of Hathaway Drive (Burnet Middle School).

PART 5. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly.

A Traffic Engineering Investigation has been conducted by this Division to determine the posted speed limit on Cameron Road from Farmer Lane (FM 734) to 320 feet east of Yeager Lane (City Limit) (See Figure 1). The following information was collected and analyzed.

## General Comments:

Cameron Road from Farmer Lane (FM734) to Yager Lane is a narrow, 21-24 feet rural road. This section of Cameron Road is 5125 feet long with three horizontal curves requiring advisory speed of 30 40 mph . Tho existing 40 mph speed limit was established by Travis County prior to annexation of this area. Raising the existing speed limit for the short narrow straight sections could promote disregard for the curves. Additional 40 mph speed limit signs and curve warning signs with advisory speed plates are recommended for this roadway.

Based on the analysis of this information, it is my engineering judgment that the speed limit on Cameron Road from Harmer Lane (FM734) to $\mathbf{3 2 0}$ feet east of Sager Lane (City Limit) should remain 40 miles per hour.
