ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY'S CO-SPONSORSHIP OF THE 2005 AUSTIN FARMER'S MARKET; WAIVING CERTAIN FEES AND STREET CLOSURE REQUIREMENTS; AUTHORIZING IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council approves City co-sponsorship, including fee waivers and in-kind contributions for a total amount not to exceed \$25,319, for the 2005 Austin Farmer's Market, to be held each Saturday beginning on March 27, 2005, through October 29, 2005, at Republic Square Park in the City of Austin.

PART 2. The Council waives the following fees and charges to be paid by the Sustainable Food Center Austin Farmers' Market.

Sound Fee	\$ 1,023.00
Permit Fee	\$ 3,100.00
Safety Inspection Fee	\$ 2,356.00
Park Rental Fees	\$ 7,700.00
Mobile Vendor Permit Fee	\$ 90.00

PART 3. The Council authorizes the following in-kind contributions to the event:

Police for event

\$ 10,850.00

PART 4. The Council waives the street closure signature and deposit requirements for the event.

PART 5. The Council finds that the need to immediately begin preparations that affect public health and safety with regard to this event constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
