This amendment increases the amount of the professional services agreement with Colette Holt for managing the "second generation availability study" for MBE, WBE and DBE procurement programs by $\$ 30,000$ for a total agreement price of $\$ 155,000$.

A separate item on today's agenda authorizes the City to enter into Interlocal Agreements with both Travis County and Capital Metro, for their participation in the focus groups and public hearings component of the second generation availability study. Each will pay $\$ 15,000$ to the City to participate in the jointly conducted focus groups and public hearings.

This action will authorize the additional $\$ 30,000$ to be added to the professional services agreement with Colette Holt, which will be funded by both Travis County and Capital Metro, in the amount of $\$ 15,000$ each.
