AGENDA ITEM NO.: 15 AGENDA DATE: Thu 04/07/2005 PAGE: 1 of 2 <u>SUBJECT:</u> Approve an ordinance authorizing acceptance of grant funding in the amount of \$93,447 from the Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division Coverdell Forensics Science Improvement Program for the Austin Police Department, Forensic Science Division to receive training in forensic sample evidence examination; and amending the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Police Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance No. 040913-01 to appropriate \$93,447.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING:</u> Funding is available from the Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division Coverdell Forensics Science Improvement Program for the grant period February 1, 2005 to August 31, 2005. An in-kind match is not required.

This action approves an ordinance authorizing acceptance of grant funding in the amount of \$93,447 from the Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division Coverdell Forensics Science Improvement Program for the Austin Police Department, Forensic Science Division to receive training in forensic sample evidence examination; and amending Ordinance No. 040913-01 the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Operating Budget, Police Department Special Revenue Fund to appropriate \$93,447. The grant period runs from February 1, 2005 to August 31, 2005.

Funding will be utilized by APD Crime Lab employees to attend training classes and seminars covering various aspects of forensic sample evidence examination. The Austin Police Department Forensics Laboratory is preparing for American Society of Crime Laboratory Directors – Laboratory Accreditation Board (ASCLD/LAB) accreditation with a target date of September 2005. An important component of the accreditation process is the laboratory system's training program. The training program must be sufficiently comprehensive to cover all aspects of the work performed by a laboratory for each discipline in which the laboratory performs casework.

The Coverdell Forensics Science Program will enable the Forensics lab to access the training they need for the proper documentation, testing, examinations and retention of evidence.

This grant addresses the Department goals of reducing the violent crime rate and the property crime rate. It also addresses the following APD Activity Objective: The purpose of the Forensics activity is to provide timely and accurate forensic science and operational support to APD, local law enforcement and

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS AND AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005 POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET OF ORDINANCE NO. 040913-01 TO APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council authorizes the application for and acceptance of \$93,447 in grant funds from the State of Texas Governor's Office, Criminal Justice Division Coverdell Forensics Science Improvement Program for training in forensic sample evidence examination for the Police Department Forensic Science Division.

PART 2. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Police Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance No. 040913-01 to appropriate \$93,447.

PART 3. The Council finds that the need to amend the budget constitutes an emergency, a grave public necessity, and an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not, by reasonable diligence, have been included in the original budget for the current fiscal year. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
