This project includes reconstruction of 45th Street from Division Drive to Airport Boulevard. The work consists of full depth reconstruction with asphalt, replacement of water and wastewater lines, installation of new sidewalks along the north side of 45th Street from Highland Terrace to Burnet Road, existing sidewalk and sidewalk ramps, replacement of curbs and gutters, installation of pavement markings and adjustment of utilities. Two meetings were held with businesses in the project vicinity to present the project. Notices were sent to eleven affected neighborhood associations. The project manager attended two neighborhood association meetings and met with the School For the Blind. In addition, notices were placed in At Your Doorstep and Energy Plus, and were delivered to all residents adjacent to the proposed new sidewalk.

Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions and utility conflicts when working in the right-ofway, a 5% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows 420 calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to 7 general contractors. Bids were opened on January 27, 2005. The Texas Sterling Construction Limited Partnership submitted the lower of 2 bids received:


