The pavement maintenance contract will provide for the maintenance and timely repair of streets, roads, drives, parking lots, sidewalks and associated items of work throughout the landside portion of the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport. Many instances of needed pavement maintenance and repairs require specific materials, equipment, skills, and manpower that cannot be performed in-house by the airport's maintenance forces. Likewise, the nature of repairs, due to the various work area locations, types of maintenance and repair work required, timing of work and quantities, may not justify the effort of addressing these work items on a normal project level. Therefore, this contract will allow airport staff to plan, schedule, and perform maintenance and repairs on an as-needed basis with minimal disruption to daily airport operations.

The maintenance and repair work will be planned and scheduled to occur approximately three or four times during a one year period, and will be defined or grouped according to location, material quantities, and type of equipment required, in order to accomplish the work in the most economical and timely manner.

The contract allows 365 calendar days for completion of this project. The contract will allow for two 1-year extensions, as mutually agreed upon by both parties and within the overall project budget amount.

Bid documents were distributed to eight general contractors. Bids were opened on March 24, 2005. Smith Contracting Co., Inc. submitted the lowest of 4 bids received:
