
The City's HealthPlus program has served as a link to healthy living to our employees by promoting a variety of ways we can enhance our physical and mental well being. Through newsletters, seminars and activities such as Exercise for Health, FitSTEPS, Healthy Approaches: Weight Loss & Exercise, the program has raised awareness to the importance of diet and exercise.

By approving the amendment to the City Code Section 8-1-13 relating to Park use fees, Council will authorize free parking in Zilker Park, free admission to City pool facilities, Lake Walter E. Long Park and Emma Long Metropolitan Park for eligible City employees. This will provide additional venues for activities in which our eligible employees can participate.

Anticipated revenues for these fees is based upon historical utilization data and not specific events.

Procedure:				

- 1. The employee will be required to show the facility attendant a current City of Austin employee picture identification card.
- 2. Facility personnel will verify current employee status and log in facility use information necessary for tracking program utilization trends.
- 3. Upon admission, city employees will be required to follow all applicable facility rules

and regulations associated with facility access (i.e. curfews, fishing licenses, pool rules, etc.).

### ORDINANCE NO. <u>20050512-000</u>

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODE SECTION 8-1-13 RELATING TO PARK USE FEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- **PART 1.** Section 8-1-13 of the City Code is amended to read:
- § 8-1-13 FEE FOR PARK USE; EXCEPTION.
  - (A) Except as provided in this section [Subsection (B)], a person shall pay a fee or charge established by ordinance for the use of a park or a recreational activity.
  - (B) A vehicle entry fee may not be charged to:
    - (1) a vehicle bearing a current license plate issued to a veteran with disabilities under Section 502.254 (*Veterans with Disabilities*) of the Texas Transportation Code and the driver of the vehicle; or
    - (2) a person holding a current state parklands passport issued under Section 13.018(a)(2) (State Parklands Passport) of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Code.
  - (C) Notwithstanding any other provision in the Code, a City employee presenting a valid City identification card may not be charged a fee for:
    - (1) parking at Zilker Park;
    - (2) admission to:
      - (a) a City pool facility;
      - (b) Lake Walter E. Long Park; and
      - (c) Emma Long Metropolitan Park.
- PART 2. The council finds that the need to promote employee health and fitness constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and

safety.
