<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize ratification of change order # 4 to the construction contract with KEYSTONE CONSTRUCTION, INC., Austin, TX, for the Spicewood Springs/Texas Plume Odor Control Improvements Project in the amount of \$17,447, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$427,126.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING:</u> Funding in the amount of \$17,447 is included in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

In 1984, Northwest Travis County MUD No. 1 constructed the Spicewood Springs lift station. It replaced another lift station that was abandoned due to Spicewood Springs Roadway expansion. The City of Austin later acquired the lift station through annexations. The lift station receives flow from a large area in northwest Austin, primarily residential. Development of the collection system in this area was fragmented due to the multiple jurisdictions that were involved with the original construction. As a result, the lift station receives flow from five other lift stations and several gravity lines.

The majority of the flow reaching this lift station passes through a manhole on the east side of Spicewood Springs Road. This manhole has three separate lines that flow into the manhole. The geometry of this manhole and the lines entering it produce a significant amount of turbulence. Two of these lines have been in place since the lift station was constructed. The third line, an eight-inch gravity line along Texas Plume Road, was constructed in 1999. Following the construction of this line, the City of Austin started receiving odor complaints from the neighbors.

During construction of the odor control improvements at the lift station site a 3-inch force main was found to be in conflict with the alignment of a proposed bore. This line was temporarily relocated to allow the contractor to proceed with the bore under Spicewood Springs Road. This Change Order will provide for additional wastewater line installation and manhole construction to resolve the conflict with the existing 3inch force main.
