<u>SUBJECT:</u> Approve a resolution amending the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Austin Housing Finance Corporation Operating Budget of Resolution No. 040913-1 to increase the Anderson Hill Program line item by an amount equal to \$2,089,646, and to increase the Rental Housing Development Assistance Program by an amount equal to \$403,051 for a total operating budget increase equal to \$2,492,697; and authorize an amendment to the one-year service agreement with the City of Austin in an amount not to exceed \$2,492,697 for a total amount not to exceed \$16,192,367 for the purpose of increasing available funding available to the Austin Housing Finance Corporation to manage and operate various City housing programs in Fiscal Year 2004-2005.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$1,847,442 from the HOME Investment Partnership Program; \$645,255 in CDBG from the NHCD Grant Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2004-2005.

PRIOR BOARD ACTION: Council approved the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Service Agreement with the City of Austin; Board approved Service Agreement and Fiscal Year 2004 -2005 AHFC Operating Budget.

BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: N/A

This action authorizes the acceptance of the transfer of \$1,847,442 from the HOME Investment Partnership Program funds, \$403,051 in CDBG funds, and the amendment of the AHFC Service Agreement with the City of Austin, and AHFC Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Operating Budget.

The Anderson Hill Redevelopment Project is required to construct a minimum of 24 home ownership and 24 rental units as a result of a 2000 Settlement Agreement with the Anderson Community Development Corporation. 6 homeownership units have been built to date. This action will result in the funding for the construction of 18 detached single family units and 10 townhomes. All net proceeds from the sale of the single family units will be dedicated to the construction of the 24 rental units. This activity is consistent with the FY 2004/2005 Action Plan as identified under the Anderson Hill

Redevelopment Homeownership and Rental Development category.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE AUSTIN HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Austin Housing Finance Corporation (the "Corporation") approves an amendment to the Grant Operating Budget approved by AHFC Resolution No. 040913-1 as amended by AHFC Resolution 040930-3 and AHFC Resolution 20050407-AHFC002 (the "Original Resolution") for the period 1 October 2004 through 30 September 2005 by substituting in its entirety the original Grant Operating Budget set forth on Exhibit "A" to the Original Resolution with a new Grant Operating Budget set forth on Exhibit "A" to this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Corporation approves an amendment to the 2004-2005 one-year Service Agreement with the City of Austin by increasing the contract amount by \$2,492,697, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$16,192,367 to enable the Corporation to increase funding and expand the Corporation's operation of various City programs.

<u>Section 3.</u> The General Manager or the General Manager's designee is authorized to prepare, execute, attest and deliver such agreements, documents, certifications, instruments, written requests and other papers as may be favorable, necessary, or required to carry out or assist in carrying out the purposes of this Resolution.
