PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION: Reauthorized the Austin Downtown PID and approved an extension of the DAA management contract on 10/24/02. Approved the 2005/2006 DAA Service Plan and Budget of \$1,227,609 and the 2005 PID assessment rate (\$0.10 / \$100 valuation) and proposed assessment roll on November 18, 2004. Adopted a budget for the Austin Downtown PID on December 16, 2004.

This action amends the Economic Growth & Redevelopment Services Office Special Revenue Fund for the Downtown Public Improvement District (PID) to account for an increase in the contract with the Downtown Austin Alliance (DAA). In each year, beginning in FY2000, \$100,000 of total revenue has been reserved to account for revenue adjustments made to the assessment roll. Over this period, revenue adjustments have been less than the amount reserved, contributing to an excess Ending Fund Balance. \$219,049 of this Fund Balance will be used to increase the DAA's FY2005-06 contract to \$1,446,658. A reserve amount of over \$200,000 will remain in the Special Revenue Fund, for pending and potential adjustments to the assessment roll.
