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<u>SUBJECT</u>: Authorize execution of a 12-month supply agreement with TRANS AMERICAN POWER PRODUCTS, INC., Houston, TX, for steel poles and mast arms for the Public Works Department in an amount not to exceed \$264,709, with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$264,709 per extension option, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$794,127.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$66,177.25 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Operating Budget of the Public Works Department. Funding for the remaining nine months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

These materials meet or exceed the current American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, Standard Specification for Structural Supports for Highway Signs, Luminaires and Traffic signals, and are used for new traffic signal installation, maintenance and repairs of existing traffic signals to provide for a safer transportation infrastructure. The Traffic Signals Division requires this material to provide cost effective preventive maintenance on traffic signals.


