SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a 12-month supply agreement with TESSCO, INC., Hunt Valley, MD for two-way radio parts and accessories in an amount not to exceed \$75,000, with four 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$375,000.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$25,000 is available in Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Operating Budget of the Wireless Communications Services Office. Funding for the remaining eight months of the original contract period and extension option is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

PURCHASING: The lowest bid of three bids received.

<u>MBE / WBE</u>: This contract will be awarded in compliance with the Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This supply agreement provides public safety and public service departments with two-way radio repair and replacement parts and accessories through the Wireless Communications Services Office (WCSO). The inventory purchased through this contract will support public safety operations with emergency lights, antennas, batteries, tower site equipment, and vehicular accessories. Regional Radio System Coalition Partners, and other public safety agencies also purchase equipment via this contract through Interlocal Agreements with the City of Austin which support their radio telecommunications.

The selected vendor supplies equipment from a wide variety of manufacturers for multiple types of communication systems, including cellular, video cameras, trunking radios, conventional radio, mobile data, tower site infrastructure and emergency vehicles. This contract will also provide the City of Austin and Interlocal Partners with complete vehicle installation parts, antennas, fuses, cables, and accessories.

This contract will maintain the operations of the City's public safety and public service departments which utilize the Regional Radio System, Mobile Data system, and Conventional Radio system.

PRICE ANALYSIS

- a. Adequate competition.
- b. One hundred and thirteen notices were sent including three MBEs and one WBE. Ten solicitations were issued in which none were MBEs/WBEs.
- c. The new pricing represents an overall 10% increase compared to the current contract. The increase is due to manufacturing cost increases and rising transportation cost.
