<u>SUBJECT</u>: Authorize execution of a 12-month service agreement with A&R DEMOLITION, INC., Del Valle, TX, and STATEWIDE COMMERCIAL, INC., Austin, TX, for demolition services in support of the Noise Mitigation Program at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport for the Public Works Department in an amount not to exceed \$229,500, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$229,500 per extension option, for a combined total agreement amount not to exceed \$918,000.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$229,500 is available in the Fiscal Year 2004-2005 Approved Capital Budget of the Aviation Department. Funding for the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

MBE / WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract will provide much needed demolition services for the Public Works Department in support of the Noise Mitigation Program at Austin-Bergstrom International Airport. After properties are acquired by the City of Austin, those properties which are identified as not salvageable will need to be demolished in an expeditious manner in order to prevent vandalism from occurring in the vacant properties. Disturbance of asbestos-containing materials is regulated by the Texas Department of Health and removal activities will be performed by a State of Texas licensed asbestos abatement contractor under this asbestos abatement contract. It will be necessary to remove asbestos containing materials prior to the sale of select structures and/or the demolition of structures on properties acquired by the City as part of the Noise Mitigation Program.

A & R Demolition will be working on residential structures. Work will range from the demolition of mobile homes to the demolition of slab on grade structures. A & R Demolition will also follow the City of Austin procedures for the proper abandonment of existing septic tanks.

In accordance with the City of Austin's commitment to prevent pollution, the City is actively working toward minimizing the waste generated at all facilities. The Contractor will be expected to make every reasonable effort to minimize the waste streams resulting from his demolition activities.

Brush, construction-demolition waste (which includes all materials that are directly or indirectly the byproducts of construction work or that results from demolition of buildings and other structures, including, but not limited to, paper, cartons, gypsum board, wood, excelsior, rubber, and plastics), and/or rubbish that is free of putrescible and free of household wastes, shall be disposed at the City of Austin Landfill located at 10108 FM 812.

The contract was structured for award to both a primary contractor (first low bidder) and an alternate contractor (second low bidder) to assure the City of the availability of a reliable vendor for demolition services. An alternate supplier for this service is necessary when A & R Demolition has large orders with other customers that consume total service capacity, which prevents him from filling City orders which must be met by the alternate contractor.
